Armored Protection NIJ III / CEN B-6

- Ballistic protection upon approach to buildings.
- High-speed response in emergency situations.
- Slow speed shield for tactical movements in rough terrain.
- Cover for evacuation of victims/personnel.



- Reactive operations.
- Response to national emergencies.
- Ballistic protection for high-threat prisoner movements.
- Proactive stance at high-risk facilities.

LD-1 Use Cases / Scenarios



Perspective:

Deputy United States Marshal with 30 years of high-risk warrant service experience.

Scenario: Warrant service in outlying area

Current tactics –approach by unarmored vehicles, personnel utilizing tactical vests and hand-held shields, carrying equipment long distances upon approach.

Solution: The LD-1 serves as positive support, providing rifle-rated ballistic protection as well as the ability to haul certain equipment to the location over difficult terrain. The potential threat from aggressive guard dogs would be diminished. Additional personnel utilize the LD-1 as cover on approach.

General Uses: Special Operations Group

The LD-1 offers protection and maneuverability while supporting federal law enforcement missions, such as the apprehension of violent offenders, terrorist trials, high-threat prisoner movements, witness security operations, national emergencies, civil disorder, protection of at-risk health facilities and personnel, large scale seizures, actions against anti-government and militia groups, international stability and reconstruction efforts, and other missions.



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
